Trainee Online Safety & ICT Acceptable Use Policy

Sand Project Statements for Trainee

- I know that my use of college devices and internet access will be monitored
- I will only use SAND Project social media sites for the sharing of work-related content that promotes positive professional stories about The Sand Project and learning progress.
- If I use my own personal 4/5G data in College time, I will ensure that my use is legal and appropriate. SAND staff can check my browsing history even if I use my own data.
- I know that bullying in any form (on and offline) is not tolerated and I know that technology should not be used for harassment
- I will not deliberately upload, add or share any images, video, sounds or text that could upset, threaten the safety of or offend any member of the college community
- I will protect my personal information online
- I will use college equipment respectfully and carefully
- I will not access or change other people files, accounts or information
- I will only upload appropriate pictures or videos of others online and when they are relevant,
 and I have permission
- I will not share my passwords with other trainees
- I know I must always check my privacy settings are safe and private
- I will only use my personal device/mobile phone during designated break times
- I will make sure that my internet use is safe and legal, and I am aware that online actions have offline consequences
- I know that use of the colleges' ICT system for personal financial gain, gambling, political purposes or advertising is not allowed
- If I am aware of anyone trying to misuse technology, I will report it to a member of staff
- I will speak to an adult I trust if something happens to either myself or another trainee which makes me feel worried, scared or uncomfortable
